

## PUY DU FOU PREPARES A NEW SHOW IN SHANGHAI (CHINA)

Following the successful opening of Puy du Fou España in Toledo, Puy du Fou is speeding up its international expansion in China and has created a brand new artistic concept for an immersive show, due to open in the centre of Shanghai in 2022.

## CHOOSE YOUR OWN ADVENTURE IN THIS THRILLING NEW SHOW

While stepping up its research into the creation of a new Puy du Fou park in China, Puy du Fou is also launching an innovative show concept, SAGA.

Much more than just a show, SAGA SHANGHAI will represent an inspired renaissance for Puy du Fou. The new artistic concept has been designed specifically to be set up in the world's major city centres. Unlike the rural "Puy du Fou" which accompany their visitors on a 2 or 3 day journey through time, SAGA promises a 2 hour total escape, more suited to the pace of city life.

Inspired by Chinese history and legends, this ultra-immersive creation by the Puy du Fou artistic team will take its visitors back to Shanghai in the 1930's. Uniquely, visitors seal their own dramatic destiny as they progress through the experience and select their own adventures. Spectacular backdrops represent different locations and periods, allowing the story to evolve and offering visitors a total of over 26 possible adventures.

For this project, the Everbright Convention & Exhibition Centre near the Xujiahui district, will be completely transformed into the world's largest immersive experience, covering more than 40,000 m2 with its show, themed restaurant and bars. Puy du Fou plans to create 500 direct jobs in China and France for the new SAGA SHANGHAI.

## TWO NEW CHINESE PARTNERS TO BRING SAGA SHANGHAI TO LIFE

For this ambitious project, Puy du Fou has chosen to join forces with two major Chinese partners: CYTS (the tourism subsidiary of the Everbright Group) and Shanghai Xuhui Urban Renewal Investment Development Group (the investment company of the Xuhui district in the city of Shanghai). The signing of this agreement between these two partners and Puy du Fou has made it possible to create SAGA SHANGHAI, with a total investment of €76 M, or nearly 600,000,000 RMB.

Mr Geoffroy Ladet and Ms Anne Zhao, respectively CEO and Vice President of Puy du Fou Asia, Mr Qiu Wen He, Vice President and General Manager of the CYTS Company, a subsidiary of the Everbright group, and Mr Zhou, Director of Chengxin, an investment company for the Xuhui district in the city of Shanghai, met on Wednesday 19 May 2021 in Shanghai, to finalise this ambitious project. The official

signing took place at the French Consulate, in the presence of His Excellency the French Ambassador to China, Mr Laurent Bili, and the French Consul in Shanghai, Mr Benoît Guidé.

Nicolas de Villiers, President of Puy du Fou, who was unable to be there in person due to the current health restrictions declared enthusiastically: "We are proud that our new 'SAGA' concept is coming to Shanghai, China as a world first, thanks to our Chinese partners. This is our first creation in this country, which calls for other projects on which we are actively working with our French and Chinese teams. This new ultra-immersive concept in the heart of the city illustrates our ambition: to innovate and offer new thrills to the world. Our plans are for 'SAGA' to go global and discussions are already under way with several big cities worldwide."

The success of this alliance is down to the complementary skills of the three partner companies:

- Puy du Fou sets a benchmark for the whole world in the field of live show production, winning awards each year for its creative excellence and already attracting more than 40 million spectators worldwide.
- The CYTS company will contribute its expert knowledge of the Chinese leisure and tourism market.
- The Chengxin Company, an investment company for the Xuhui district of Shanghai, has made every effort to bring this new concept to Shanghai as a world first.

## About Puy du Fou

Puy du Fou was created in 1978 as a totally one-of-a-kind artistic concept. Puy du Fou, twice elected "Best Theme Park in the World" in March 2012 in Los Angeles (Thea Classic Award) then in November 2014 in Orlando (Applause Award), draws from the collective imagination and stages legendary worlds in spectacular shows filled with universal emotion. Puy du Fou has invented a unique artistic model in the world of leisure, a new type of experience, where visitors discover spectacular world-class shows and are immersed in ultra-realistic realms infused with history and legend. Puy du Fou is a group mainly comprised of an association created under the French 1901 Act and an SAS (simplified joint-stock company) at the head of several subsidiaries. In France, the association organises the Cinéscénie show with 4,300 volunteers and owns the SAS which manages the Grand Parc (63 daytime/night-time shows, 4 historic villages, 22 restaurants and 6 themed hotels) and employs 2,500 people. The two entities secure their future by financing the Puy du Fou Academy (an "Arts & Studies" school) and the Junior Academy (an artistic training centre) which train over 700 young people every year in performing arts and techniques. With Puy du Fou International, the park disseminates its expertise and know-how around the world; it has just created a park in Spain, based on the Puy du Fou model, and designing shows on other continents. After Spain, Puy du Fou is now establishing itself in China with its immersive show "Saga" and is accelerating its research to create a park based on the Puy du Fou model in the years to come.
